Title: S13-1 "Establishment of Student Commissioners"

Whereas, The Student Senate of Modesto Junior College is invested in Article VIII of the ASMJC Constitution with the authority to establish "any positions, boards, and committees" with a two-thirds (2/3) vote;

Whereas, The Student Senate recognizes that its subject matter jurisdiction includes divisions/departments on campus that exist outside of the realm of instruction including, but not limited to, student services programs;

Whereas, Representation of student interests in those areas is integral to the charge of the Student Senate, reaffirming the organization's right to participate effectively in matters that can or will affect students as articulated in §51023.7 of Title 5 regulations.

Whereas, Until such time that a referendum may be held to amend the ASMJC Constitution to formally codify the positions stated herein, the Student Senate may establish such positions in the interim;

Resolved, That the Student Senate for Modesto Junior College establish the following positions:

- Student Commissioner for Community Relations
- Student Commissioner for Diversity
- Student Commissioner for Library and Information Technology
- Student Commissioner for Matriculation, Admissions, and Records
- Student Commissioner for Special Programs

Resolved, That the Student Senate for Modesto Junior College confer unto these positions all the privileges and responsibilities of Student Senators;

Resolved, That the Student Senate for Modesto Junior College shall establish these positions be dissolved upon the passage of a referendum formally codifying these positions in the ASMJC Constitution; and

Resolved, That the Student Senate for Modesto Junior College reserves the right to create, amend, combine, and/or dissolve any of these positions with a two-thirds (2/3) vote of the Student Senate.
