



Student Ways & Means Protection Act

WHEREAS over the past two years the Associated Students of Columbia College has advocated on behalf of the student body to the appropriate participatory governance committees to impart the financial burden that fingerprinting places on students.

WHEREAS the District Policy 7337 contains language that the students do not agree with: “All employees, student workers, and volunteers are personally responsible to pay the cost of the fingerprinting and processing.”

WHEREAS there is no implemented or a foreseen implementation of a process that will impart the financial burden that fingerprinting places on students.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT the Associated Students of Columbia College request that District Policy 7337 be sent back to the appropriate committees to allow the colleges and/or district to implement a process that will impart the financial burden the fingerprinting places on students.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT the Associated Students of Columbia College petitions the Yosemite Community College District to strike the language “All employees, student workers, and volunteers are personally responsible to pay the cost of the fingerprinting and processing” from District Policy 7337.

BE IT ADDITIONALLY RESOLVED THAT the Associated Students of Columbia College does not support any student having to pay out of pocket for fingerprinting.
